Christ is all, and in all

— Col 3:11 (KJV)

I am the Alpha and the Omega, says
the Lord God, who is and who was
and who is to come, the Almighty
— Rev. 1:8 (kjv)

Christ is all:

Christ was always God --

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was
with God, and the Word was God. The same was in
the beginning with God.

— John 1:1-2 (KJV)

He is the image of the invisible God -

Who is the image of the invisible God,

— Col 1:15 (KJV)

And in him is all the fullness of the Godhead --

that in all things he might have the preeminence. For
it pleased the Father that in him should all fullness
dwell.

— Col 1:18, 19 (KJV)

God the Father has exalted him above all things -

Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly,
that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have
crucified, both Lord and Christ

— Acts 2:36 (KJV)

And He is Lord of all -

Jesus Christ: (he is Lord of all:)

— Acts 10:36 (KJV)

Christ made all things –

All things were made by him; and without him was not anything made that was made.
In him was life; and the life was the light of men.

— John 1:3,4 (KJV)

For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.

— Col 1:16, 17 (KJV)

Christ is the source of true life --

Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

— John 8:12 (KJV)

I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

— John 10:10-11 (KJV)

Christ is the way of salvation –

Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: And by him all that believe are justified

— Acts 13:38-39 (KJV)

In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:

— Col 1:14 (KJV)

I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

— John 10:9 (KJV)

And Christ is the only way of salvation –

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

— John 14:6 (KJV)

Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name (than the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth), under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. — Acts 4: 12 (KJV)

Christ's provision is all:

Christ provides salvation to those who believe on Him --

And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved

— Acts 16:30-31 (KJV)

And eternal life –

Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?

— John 11:25-26 (KJV)

He saves us completely –

Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

— Heb 7:25 (KJV)

And He keeps us secure in his salvation –

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

— John 10:27-28 (KJV)

He gives us complete peace –

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

— John 14:27 (KJV)

He enables us to do whatever He calls us to --

I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

— Phil 4:13 (KJV)

He will ultimately present us to God holy, unblameable and unprovable –

And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unprovable in his sight:

— Col 1:21-22 (KJV)

Christ's demand is all:

Christ asks that we love him completely –

Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment.

— Matthew 22:37 -38 (KJV)

Christ requires that we give up everything for Him –

And when he had called the people unto him with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it.

— Mark 8:34 -35 (KJV)

If any man come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple. And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple.

— Luke 14:26-27 (KJV)

We are to live for Christ, and not for ourselves –

He died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again.

— 2 Cor 5:15 (KJV)

We are to crucify the flesh, and our passions and desires –

And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. Gal 5:24 (KJV)

Christ requires that we obey him –

If ye love me, keep my commandments.

— John 14:15 (KJV)

If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

— John 15:10 (KJV)

And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say? — Luke 6:46 (KJV)

Jesus requires that we do the will of the Father –

Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

— Matt 7:21 (KJV)

Jesus requires that we be witnesses for him –

But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

— Acts 1:8 (KJV)

Jesus requires that we love one another –

A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.

— John 13:34 (KJV)

But the "burdens" he asks are easy, and they give rest to our souls –

Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. — Matt 11:29-30 (KJV)
